Bible Focus: The angels tell about Jesus.

Shepherds • Luke 2:6-18

Memory Verse: "God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son." John

3:16, GNT

Key Question: Why is Jesus special? **Bottom Line:** Jesus is God's Son.

Basic Truth: Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

Make It True (Large Group, 20 minutes)

Historyteller Greets children at the door as music plays.

CG: Welcome Slide ("Get Up")

Stop music once all classes are in and on a line.

Worship

What You Need: Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible at John 3:16."

HISTORYTELLER: "Yay! I'm so glad to see you today. It's almost Christmas. I'm so excited to celebrate Jesus' birthday! This month has been awesome as we are learning to say, [Bottom Line] 'Jesus is God's Son.' Why is Jesus special?"

CG: Bottom Line Slide

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: [Bottom Line] "Jesus is God's Son."

HISTORYTELLER: "Yes! Jesus is God's Son, and we celebrate His birthday at Christmas. Let's sing our song about that together.

SFX: "Christmas Party"

"Great singing, my friends. You are all so amazing. Why is Jesus special?"

CG: Bottom Line Slide

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: [Bottom Line] "Jesus is God's Son."

HISTORYTELLER: "Yes! *[Bottom Line]* **Jesus is God's Son.** It's time to practice our memory verse. Are you ready?

CG: Memory Verse Slide

God (point up) loved (hug yourself) the world (raise arms overhead to form a circle) so much (stretch arms out as far as possible) that he gave (place hands together with palms up in front as if offering something) his only (point up) Son (hold arms as if cradling and rocking a baby), John 3:16. (Hold hands open like a book.) Do that with me."

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: "God (point up) loved (hug yourself) the world (raise arms overhead to form a circle) so much (stretch arms out as far as possible) that he gave (place hands together with palms up in front as if offering something) his only (point up) Son (hold arms as if cradling and rocking a baby), John 3:16." (Hold hands open like a book.) (Repeat several times.)

HISTORYTELLER: "I am so proud of you all! You are doing a GREAT job with that verse. Are you ready to sing another song with me? (*Pause*.) You are? Let's sing.

SFX: "Special Delivery"

"Way to go, friends. Great singing. I am so thankful that God loves me and He sent us His Son, Jesus. **Why is Jesus special?**"

CG: Bottom Line Slide

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: [Bottom Line] "Jesus is God's Son."

Bible

What You Need: Bible and costume angel wings

(Historyteller enters carrying a Bible and wearing the angel wings.)

HISTORYTELLER: "I'm pretending that today is Angel Day! See?

(Turn around for the children to see the angel wings.)

"Angel wings! I'm pretending to be an angel because in today's Bible Truth angels appeared to announce that Jesus was born. They came to announce Jesus' birthday! You know, the reason why we're having the biggest, bestest Birthday Bash ever!

(Open the Bible.)

"The angels were a big part of Jesus' birthday celebration. You see, Jesus, God's Son, had just been born. That same night, there were shepherds watching their sheep, because that's what shepherds do. They watch sheep. Do you remember what a sheep sounds like? Let me hear you make a sheep sound.

(Pause.)

"Fantastic! You sound like a lot of sheep!

"Well, one night the shepherds were watching all of their sheep and all of a sudden an angel appeared and said to them and said, 'The baby has been born! He is God's Son! Go find Him in the manger!' Then the whole sky was filled with more angels singing and praising God saying, 'Glory to God in the highest!'

"Would you like to pretend to be an angel with me? (Pause for response.) Great! Everyone stand up. Hold out your pretend angel wings like this.

(Hold your arms out and move them slowly up and down.)

"Let's say, 'Glory to God in the highest!' while we move our pretend wings. Ready?"

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: "Glory to God in the highest!"

HISTORYTELLER: "Again!"

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: "Glory to God in the highest!"

HISTORYTELLER: "One more time!"

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: "Glory to God in the highest!"

HISTORYTELLER: "Great job! You can sit back down now.

(Wait for children to sit down.)

"The shepherds were excited about Jesus being born because [Bottom Line] Jesus is God's Son. Why is Jesus special?"

CG: Bottom Line Slide

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: [Bottom Line] "Jesus is God's Son!"

HISTORYTELLER: "You got it! So as soon as the angels left, the shepherds ran to see baby Jesus. When they saw Him, they knew He was the most special baby and they wanted to go and tell everyone. So they did!

"Stand up and let's pretend to be shepherds this time. Put your hands around your mouth like this.

(Cup hands around each side of your mouth.)

"And let's tell everyone that **[Bottom Line]** Jesus is God Son. Here we go! Say it with me!"

CHILDREN and HISTORYTELLER: [Bottom Line] "Jesus is God Son! [Bottom Line] Jesus is God Son! [Bottom Line] Jesus is God's Son!"

HISTORYTELLER: "Wow! You make great shepherds. You can sit back down now.

(Pause for children to sit.)

"Jesus is special because **[Bottom Line]** Jesus is God Son. That's why we're throwing the biggest, bestest Birthday Bash ever, because we're celebrating Christmas, the day Jesus was born.

"God loves us so much that He sent his Son, Jesus. Pretty special, don't you think?

Offering and Prayer

Music Plays as the offering container is passed around

SFX: "How Great is our God?"

Bring volume down to signify prayer time.

HISTORYTELLER: "Let's pray and thank God for how special Jesus is."

"Dear God, thank You for giving us Jesus. He is so special. I pray each person in here will understand one day how special a gift Jesus is to all of us. He is the BEST gift! Help us tell others about Jesus the way the shepherds did. We want everyone to know that Jesus is Your Son and You gave Him to us to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

Dismiss

"Well, that's it for today. Have fun and I'll see you next time. Bye!"
