

# Jesus Calms the Storm Mark 4:35-41; Matthew 8:23-27; Luke 8:22-25



Jesus and his disciples are out in a boat when a fierce storm comes up. Their boat is full of water, and they think they're going to drown. Jesus stops the storm with just a few words. The disciples are in awe that <u>Jesus has power</u> <u>to calm storms</u>.

### **Family Together Time**

Play this fun game to help family members remember that <u>Jesus has power to calm</u> storms.

- Fill a bathtub or large plastic tote with enough water for something to float in.
- Put a small item that floats into the water.
- Make waves! Have family members simultaneously try to get the floating item to the other end without touching it with their hands.
- Compare what happened to the boat in the game to what happened to the disciples' boat in the storm.
- Remind your family that <u>Jesus has</u> power to calm our storms just as he calmed the storm for the disciples.
