

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to parkwayfellowship.com and Parkway Fellowship and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Parkway Fellowship include parkwayfellowship.com and Parkway. The Parkway website is a Church Website site. By using the Parkway website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Parkway may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- Name
- Address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number

If you purchase Parkway's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

Parkway may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

- Age
- Gender
- Race
- Religion
- Political Affiliation
- Household Income

We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Parkway's public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

Parkway encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Parkway so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Parkway is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Parkway website.

Use of your Personal Information

Parkway collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Parkway may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Parkway and its affiliates. Parkway may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Parkway does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Parkway may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Parkway, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Parkway may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Parkway, in order to determine what Parkway services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Parkway to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Parkway will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Parkway or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Parkway; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Parkway, or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Parkway. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Parkway website.

Use of Cookies

The Parkway website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Parkway pages, or register with Parkway site or services, a cookie helps Parkway to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Parkway website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Parkway features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Parkway services or websites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

Parkway secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. Parkway uses the following methods for this purpose:

- SSL Protocol

When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol.

Children Under Thirteen

Parkway collects personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. Parkway collects this information for the following reason(s): Event and Services Registration.
